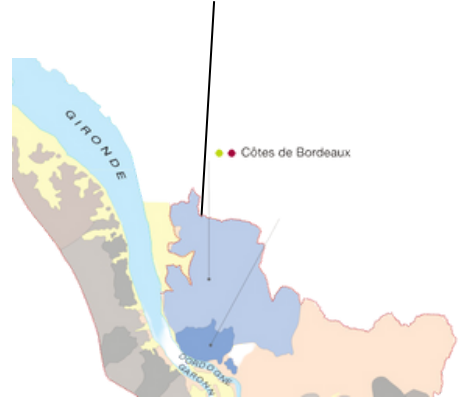


Château Plaisance
