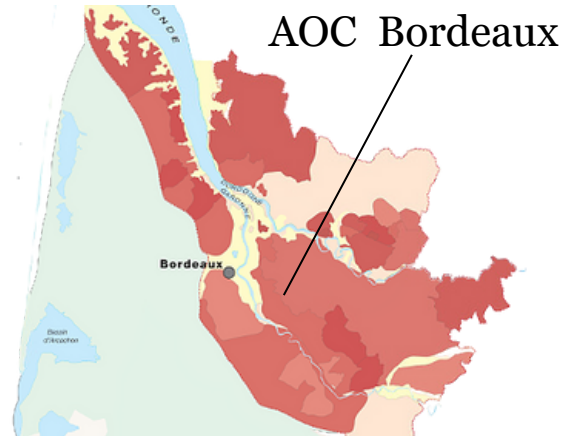


Château Plaisance
